To logon to St George Girls High School network on a school computer:

Select Ctrl Alt Del

Enter your network username e.g. jessica.wang3@detnsw and your password



To logon to the DET Student Portal - at school, home or on your laptop:

Enter your user name in this format - user name@detnsw e.g. jessica.wang3@detnsw

Enter your password

Changing Passwords

You can change your portal password by logging onto your DoE account and selecting the Change Password Option at <https://student.det.nsw.edu.au/>.


If you have forgotten your password, come to the server room in the library to reset.

To logon to the DoE Wi-Fi on your laptop

Joining a device to the school wifi and authenticating it to the DoE network should only need to be completed when it is first brought to school or if a password is changed.


For Windows

1. Click on the globe icon on the task bar at the bottom right of the device.




2. Select **detnsw**.

- If you do not see any wifi options check you have wifi turned on.
- If you see other wifi options but not the options in the image seek technical support in the library.



3. Check on connect automatically and select Connect.



4. Type in your DoE username and password – format as **username@detnsw**.


5. Select OK.




6. This dialogue box will appear if authentication occurs

Select Connect.

The device will be on the detnsw network.



7. The wifi should show detnsw as Connected and secured.



For Mac

1. Click on the wireless image on the task bar at the top right of the device.



2. Select **detnsw**.

- If you do not see any wifi options check you have wifi turned on.



3. Type in your DoE username and password – format as **username@detnsw**

4. Select Join.



5. This dialogue box will appear

Click "Continue"

The device will be on the detnsw network



Note: **MacBook users**. Go to System Preferences → Network → Advanced → Proxies → Tick Auto Proxy discovery, OK and Apply

Printing Account

You will be given \$5.00 credit as a start for your printing account. After you use this amount you will need to add credit to your account at the circulation desk using your student ID card. You will receive this ID card after the school photographs have been taken. To add credit to your printing account prior to receiving this card see the staff in the library.

To check your printing credit, logon to a school computer and on the desktop click on the shortcut as shown below, and select **My Printer Balance**.



Printing from your laptop

Printing can be done via the School website which you should have as a favourite on your laptop. Select BYOD Printing from the menu and follow the instructions to install the **Mobility Print Client**.








Microsoft Office 365
