## Personal Computing Device Specifications

Hardware Specifications	
Device Type	Laptop or Tablet device
	<b>Note:</b> SMART Phones are not considered an appropriate personal computing device.
Keyboard Attachment	A tablet device should have a physical keyboard attachment and keys must move when physically depressed.
Screen	Minimum Screen size – approximately 27cm. (Screen Size is the diagonal measurement)
Recommended Operating System	Microsoft Windows 10 or Windows 11. Apple Mac OS 10.13 or newer.
	<b>Note</b> : while Chromebooks may be used, applications are limited. iPads are not recommended
Wireless Compatibility	<ul> <li>Device must have 5GHz 802.11n support.</li> <li>This may be advertised as "Wi-Fi 5", "Wi-Fi 6", "Dual Band Wireless", "802.11abgn", "802.11agn", "802.11ac" or "Gigabit Wireless".</li> <li>Devices sold as "802.11bgn" are unlikely to support the required standard.</li> <li>Important Note:</li> <li>Devices with 2.4GHz only are not supported.</li> <li>Wireless Compatibility of devices is often a difficult requirement to verify. This information is not always readily available on the actual device or at the place of purchase.</li> </ul>
Storage and RAM	A minimum storage of <b>250 GB</b> (disk configuration: Solid State Drive - SSD) for Laptops, and minimum <b>8 GB RAM</b> to process data rapidly.

Additional Recommendations	Battery Life should be six hours as there will not be facilities for charging the device at school. Protective cover or case for device. Device should not be too heavy to carry in bag each day.
